- An extended height toilet is a simple, attractive solution that is 2 1/2 to 3 inches higher. A Toilevator is another option.
- A bidet bath seat turns any toilet into a bidet.
- Commodes and Shower/Commode chairs are also useful options—they sit or roll over an existing toilet and raise the usable height.
- A sit-to-stand toilet can be installed to aid in using the commode.
